Any person, ages up to 16 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. All contestants must possess a valid fishing license for the waters fished. Indiana Walleye reserves the right to accept or reject any applications.

SPORTSMANSHIP: Entrants must conduct themselves in a true sportsman like manner at all times. NO EXCEPTIONS. Courtesy and ethics of the highest standard are the norm, not the exception. Remember that you not only represent yourselves, but all IW anglers and competitive fishing. Any rude or insulting type of behavior will be subject to disqualification.
